


GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS

Welcome to JEMS2022 Conference!

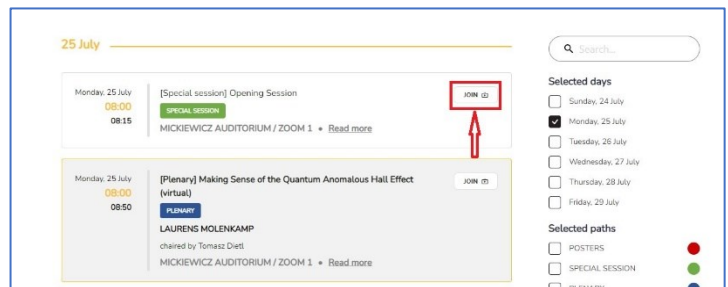
The oral presentations for this event will be held in hybrid form with virtual connections via ZOOM MEETING and with on-site participants being there at the conference venue.

To check the most up-to-date schedule and join the session, simply go to <https://jems2022.pl/live> and use the e-mail address you provided in the registration form to log in.

Once logged in, search for your preferred session, speaker or presentation title using filters or SEARCH field and simply click JOIN button. You will be re-directed to ZOOM.



IMPORTANT NOTE ON POSTER SESSIONS

Poster sessions are to be run exclusively in the online form. For onsite participants willing to connect to the poster session at the conference venue, all conference rooms at Auditorium Maximum and Old Library Buildings will be open. The audience has to use their own portable devices to connect to poster ZOOM breakout rooms. **Do not forget to bring your own laptop, tablet or any other portable device to connect to the poster session.**

Technical requirements for virtual participation

- Computer with Internet access, camera and microphone.
- ZOOM software installed – latest version. For ZOOM download, click [HERE](#).
- Internet access of minimum 1 Mbps, broadband connection is recommended.
- External USB headphones with a microphone are highly recommended. In case you use wireless headphones (e.g., with a Bluetooth connection), please make sure the battery is fully charged.
- Your computer or audio equipment may have its own mute or disable settings – make sure to check that everything is 'on'.
- We recommend closing all windows or applications that are not needed (especially those using a camera and / or microphone, e.g., Skype, MS Teams, Webex) to ensure the best performance of the platform.
- It is also highly recommended to keep your microphone muted and camera off and turn both on while planning to speak.
